


Open internet explorer and go to <https://63.226.77.2>


If you get a security warning after selecting "Install ActiveX Control" click on install.



If you at any time receive a security alert regarding the certificate for this site, click on "Yes" you want to proceed.




The installation process will run its course and automatically connect you to the VPN then you will see this window when it is complete.
